Final action on bills previously heard

HB2522 - *Representative Goico moved to favorably pass **HB2522** out of Committee, seconded by Representative Lusker. Motion carried.*

HB2605 - *Representative Sloan moved to pass **HB2605** favorably out of Committee, seconded by Representative Ryckman. Representative Sloan then moved to adopt a balloon amendment that would authorize the Turnpike Director or the Director's designee to instruct the Division of Vehicles to refuse to register or renew registration of a vehicle only if the outstanding amount of any tolls, penalties, fees, or costs due and owing by the registered owner exceeds \$100. The Motion was seconded by Representative Doll and the Motion carried.*

Back on the bill as amended. *After further discussion Representative Sloan moved to favorably pass **HB2605, as amended**, seconded by Representative Doll. The Motion carried.*

HB2641 - *Representative Schwartz moved to favorably pass **HB2641**, seconded by Representative Todd. There was discussion and the Motion did not carry.*

HB2643 - *Representative Doll moved to favorably pass **HB2643**, seconded by Representative Ryckman. Votes were counted upon a show of hands, and the Motion carried.*
