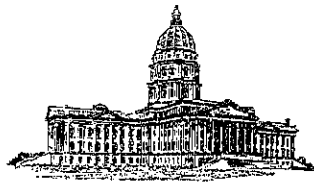

RE: HB 2033; Written Testimony

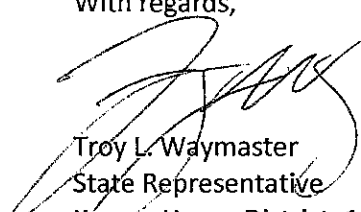
Dear House Transportation Committee:

I submit this written testimony in support of House Bill 2033. I received a call from a constituent of mine in Rush County that experienced the very same issue that this bill will prevent. He was safely passing a vehicle and exceeded the speed limit on a two lane road. He received a ticket for exceeding the speed limit in order to pass the other vehicle, even though he was driving safely.

There are many two lane roads in Kansas all which have different terrains. The passage of House Bill 2033 would allow someone to safely pass another vehicle on a two lane road by allowing them to exceed the stated speed limit, up to 10 miles per hour, in order to do so.

I contend that this bill will provide clarity for many drivers and ensure safety for those that may need to exceed the stated speed limit in order to pass another vehicle on a two lane road. I look forward to the passage of House Bill 2033 and the ability to vote for its passage on the House floor.
