1 AN ACT concerning memorial highways relating to signage, requiring the
2 secretary of transportation to collect sufficient funds prior to
3 installation; designating the 2nd Lieutenant Justin L. Sisson memorial
4 highway, the George Ablah expressway and the Kenneth W. Bernard
5 memorial highway; amending K.S.A. 68-1034 and K.S.A. 2014 Supp.
6 68-10,106 and repealing the existing sections.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

9 New Section 1. On and after July 1, 2015, the secretary of
10 transportation shall not place any signs commemoratively designating any
11 highway, bridge, interchange or trail until the secretary has received
12 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for
13 the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to
14 defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The
15 secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations
16 to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

17 New Sec. 2. That portion of United States highway 69 from the
18 junction of United States highway 69 and 135th street in Johnson county,
19 then south on United States highway 69 to the junction of United States
20 highway 69 and 167th street is hereby designated as the 2nd Lieutenant
21 Justin L. Sisson memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall
22 place highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals
23 to indicate that the highway is the 2nd Lieutenant Justin L. Sisson
24 memorial highway, except that such signs shall not be placed until the
25 secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to
26 reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an
27 additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or
28 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may
29 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and
30 installing suitable signs.

31 New Sec. 3. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with
32 interstate highway 135 then east to the junction with Rock Road in
33 Sedgwick county is hereby designated as the George Ablah expressway.
34 The secretary of transportation shall place markers along the highway
35 right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the
36 George Ablah expressway, except that such signs shall not be placed

1 until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and
2 donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs
3 and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or
4 replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may
5 accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and
6 installing suitable signs.

7 Sec. 4. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 68-10,106 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 68-10,106. The portion of K-96 highway from the junction with
9 ~~interstate highway 135~~ Rock Road in Sedgewick county then east to the
10 junction with interstate highway 35 is hereby designated as the Bonnie
11 Huy memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place
12 markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate
13 that the highway is the Bonnie Huy memorial highway, except that such
14 signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient
15 moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost
16 of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray
17 future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of
18 transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in
19 obtaining and installing suitable signs.

20 New Sec. 5. That portion of K-7 highway from the southern city
21 limits of the city of Lansing then north on K-7 highway to the northern
22 city limits of the city of Lansing is hereby designated as the Kenneth W
23 Bernard memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place
24 highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to
25 indicate that the highway is the Kenneth W Bernard memorial highway,
26 except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received
27 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary
28 for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial
29 cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs.
30 The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and
31 donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

32 Sec. 6. K.S.A. 68-1034 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-
33 1034. From the junction of United States highway 24 and United States
34 highway 40 with United States highway 73 and highway K-7, United
35 States highway 73 and highway K-7 north to the southern city limits of
36 Lansing, then north from the northern city limits of Lansing to the eastern
37 junction with United States highway 59 in the city of Atchison, United
38 States highway 73 west to the junction with United States highway 159,
39 is hereby designated as the Amelia Earhart memorial highway. The
40 secretary of transportation shall place markers along the highway right-
41 of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Amelia
42 Earhart memorial highway. The secretary of transportation may accept
43 and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining suitable highway

1 *signs bearing the proper approved inscription.*

4 *~~Sec. 7.~~ 8.* This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its

5 publication in the statute book.

Sec. 7. Bridge no. 14(030) on Kansas highway 15 in Clay county is hereby designated as the Clay county Vietnam veterans bridge. The secretary of transportation shall place suitable signs to indicate the bridge is the Clay county Vietnam veterans bridge, except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.

Sec. 8. The junction of interstate highway 70 and 110th street in Wyandotte county is hereby designated as the Bert Cantwell memorial interchange. The secretary of transportation shall place signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that the junction of interstate highway 70 and 110th street is the Bert Cantwell memorial interchange, except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the initial cost to defray future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in obtaining and installing suitable signs.
