Chairperson Wolf called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.

The Chairperson stated to the Committee that during the last meeting, October 5, 2016, information was provided by the Department of Administration pertaining to a proposal to open a new snack bar located in the Visitor Center of the Statehouse. The Chairperson stated she called this meeting to discuss additional information pertaining to the funding for this proposal, provided to the Committee after the last meeting.

Amy Deckard, Kansas Legislative Research Department, detailed the source of moneys for this project. She stated the project operates with federal moneys and revenue generated from the sale of goods at the snack bar location ([Attachment 1](#) and [Attachment 2](#)). Information was also provided as to the relationship between the new proposed location and the facility currently in operation on the third floor of the Statehouse. Committee discussion of this information followed.

A motion was made by Senator Francisco, seconded by Representative Alford, after receiving additional information on the proposed Capitol Visitor Center snack bar, stating the Committee does not object to the advancement of this project. The motion failed.

Further Committee discussion occurred.

A motion was made by Representative Hutton, seconded by Representative Alford, to reconsider the previous motion. The motion passed.

A motion was made by Senator Francisco, seconded by Representative Hutton, after receiving information pertaining to the revenue source for the cost of construction of the proposed Visitor Center snack bar, stating the Committee does not object to the advancement of this project. The motion passed.
