9 MILLION Units completed in CORE 5 since the beginning of KRI
This reflects Kansas students closing 9 million skill gaps since August of 2013!

Skills addressed might include: rhyming, beginning and ending sounds, short and long vowels, word families, contractions, syllable division, high frequency sight words, sentence structure, synonyms and antonyms, Greek combing forms, comprehension skills such as main idea, sequencing, inferencing, cause and effect, summarizing to mention only a few.

- 149 Schools met criteria in the first year of the grant
- 16 Schools did not meet criteria but showed progress

ADDITIONAL INTERESTING KRI INFORMATION

- -On Average, students met their weekly recommended minutes on the program over 70% of the time.
- -60% of schools this year have students meeting 60% or more of their recommended minutes for 15 or more weeks (174 schools out of 289).
- **-20% of Kansas Students K-5 are currently using Lexia Reading CORE 5** (roughly 38,000)
- -Cost per student, runs about \$50 per student per year
- -Not aware of any school that added staff to implement and support KRI
