It is further understood, if our school is placed on the KSHSAA "Approved List" it shall be permitted to compete with KSHSAA member schools, but shall not be eligible to participate in Association-sponsored activities, tournaments or events which are conducted for the purpose of determining an official KSHSAA championship.

Our fee will cover the following services rendered by the KSHSAA: (1) Placement on the mailing list to receive one copy of each publication (Calendar, KSHSAA Handbook, Manuals, etc.), which will improve communications and make us aware of the rules and regulations which are followed by the member schools against whom we may compete; (2) placement on the mailing list to receive the monthly Activities Journal; (3) staff (not students) will be allowed to attend rules meetings, clinics, seminars, conferences conducted by the KSHSAA staff, etc.; and (4) our school will be listed in the KSHSAA Directory and website as an approved school. An additional \$50 debate participation fee (if applicable) is enclosed for participation in invitational debate tournaments.
