1 AN ACT concerning schools; relating to the Kansas state high school
2 activities association; relating to participation by certain students.

3 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

4 Section 1. Any student who is a resident of a school district shall be
5 permitted to participate in any activities offered by such school district
6 regardless of whether such student attends a school in such school district
7 on a full-time basis. Nothing in this section shall be construed to permit a
8 student to participate in an activity if such student is otherwise prohibited
9 from participating for any reason other than attendance, or if such student
10 is prohibited from participating because of truancy. Any student
11 participating in high school activities shall be allowed to participate for
12 four consecutive school years regardless of whether such student graduates
13 prior to the completion of the fourth school year, provided such student is
14 20 years of age or younger at the time of participation.

15 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
16 publication in the statute book.

extracurricular

To the extent any participation fees are required to be paid by a student participating in an activity, the same fees shall be paid by any student participating in such activity despite not attending a school in such school district on a full-time basis.

(b) As used in this section, the term "extracurricular activity" means an activity that does not fall within the scope of the school district's general curriculum.
