To Members of the Education Committee:

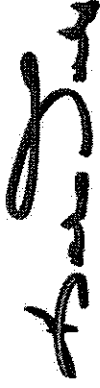
Thank you for the opportunity to offer written testimony in support of SB 470, an act establishing the intercollegiate adaptive sport grant program.
