I have seen up close how many families have been destroyed by "court investigators" and "case workers" and the "judges" that simply follow the recommendation of these people with absolutely no investigation of their own.

I ask you to pass this bill for the families but most of all to protect the children from cruel and unusual punishment that can impact the rest of their lives especially when the rate of false allegations seems to be more common than not.

After all, they are the ones being punished with decisions that could have been handled in a way that the trauma they have endured didn't have to happen.

The goal is to protect children and support parents and keep families together.
