

KANSAS ASSOCIATION OF COUNTIES NEUTRAL TESTIMONY ON SB 425 FEBRUARY 18, 2016

Mr. Chairman and Members of the Senate Natural Resources Committee,

KAC appears as a neutral conferee on SB 425 because we have member counties who both support and oppose the bill.

As written, SB 425 allows a board of county commissioners to regulate the granting of a conservation easement on property located within the county. Regulation of the easement is defined to mean adoption by resolution of a standard, requirement or other policy pertaining to the duration, type, process, procedure or category of property eligible for a conservation easement.

KAC notes that the legislation allows a county commission to regulate easements, which is generally a private land transaction. Involvement in private property transfers may involve the county in an individual's estate planning and tax planning, which could lead to potential litigation against the county.
