Chairperson Pilcher-Cook opened the presentation on the Kansas Tracking and Reporting of Controlled Substances (K-TRACS).

Alexandra Blasi, Kansas Board of Pharmacy, presented an overview on K-TRACS. Ms. Blasi provided information on the Prescription Monitoring Program (PMP) Advisory Committee, some PMP comparisons with other states, information on Reporting, examples of Controlled Substances, Drugs of Concern, Substances Monitored, Data Confidentiality, Threshold Letters, Violations and Penalties, Funding, Potential Improvements, and some Preliminary Findings. Questions by the committee were addressed by Ms. Blasi and Carly Haynes, Pharmacy Inspector. In response to a question from a committee member, Ms. Blasi addressed some of the challenges that would be presented regarding the use of K-TRACS to monitor the use of psychotropic drugs on senior citizens in long-term care settings. Ms. Blasi stated that it may be challenging in the long-term care setting to identify what level is beyond normal or an appropriate standard of care and then identifying that in the K-TRACS system. Ms. Blasi indicated that because psychotropic drugs are not on any one list of schedule, they would each have to be identified and added to the drugs of concern. (Attachment 1)
