I'm going to make this short and sweet. My son Jayden was diagnosed with Dravet syndrome. He was having 500 myoclonic seizures a day and 1 to 3 grandmals a day that lasted an hour and was sent to ER over 30 times in ambulance.

He couldn't walk, he couldn't chew and he couldn't leave the house. He was on 4 different anti-epileptic drugs, he was taking 22 pills a day and he was getting worse from the side effects and seizures. My son was the first child recorded using cannabis for epilepsy 3 and half years ago.

Since then we have weaned him off 20 pills and we are down to 2 pills. He is running and playing and happy. His seizures are down 90 to 95%, he is able to chew and he is able to go anywhere and have fun now. His seizures now last about 5 to 30 seconds and since starting cannabis we have had 0 ambulance rides.

Thank God we have found a God given plant to help save our son's life instead of giving him man-made chemicals that almost killed him and made him severely disabled.
