Pharmacy Utilization Facts Calendar Year 2014



Mental health medications and age:

- 479 children under the age of 6 (outside of FDA approved age limits)
- 50 members over the age of 70 (potential member safety issue)
- Approximately \$2.9M in annual spend

Total spend on mental health prescriptions for members without a matching diagnosis: \$4.5M
