I have been notified that Bill SB5 presented to the Kansas Senate and sent to the Transportation Committee on 1/12/15 is to establish a portion of Hwy 69 in Overland Park, Kansas to be named the **2LT Justin Lee Sisson Memorial Highway**. My husband, Larry, and I were thrilled to hear that this is being considered!

Justin was an outstanding young man that influenced many young men and women during his too short lifetime. Because Justin felt so strongly about defending our freedoms, he interrupted his college education to enlist and serve in the war. He came back to finish his college career and commissioned into the Army as a 2LT in May 2012. He died honorably defending the freedoms we enjoy in our great nation in June 2013.

Justin lived and attended high school in Kansas. Having part of Highway 69 named in Justin's honor would mean so much to his family and many friends. I think this bill proposes a significant memorial that Kansas as a state should consider to honor a fallen hero. My husband and I want to communicate our support for this bill.
