We are writing to ask your support for SB5 which would establish that a portion of Highway 69 in Overland Park, Kansas be named "The Justin Lee Sisson Memorial Highway." As you most likely know, Justin was Killed in Action on June 3, 2013 in Paktia Province, Afghanistan.
