Serial Number Requirement for Registration Renewal Decals

Mr. Chairman and members of the committee, thank you for the opportunity to testify on House Bill 2091.

The Division of Vehicles is a proponent.

Currently, K.S.A. 8-134(e) requires that vehicle plate registration decals “be numbered serially in each county and shall indicate the year in which such registration expires.” The requirement for decals to be numbered serially is a hold-over from the previous motor vehicle registration system. The current MVS system prints the plate number on the registration decal to correspond with the license plate number on the vehicle which makes the serial number requirement obsolete. We are proposing amending this section to reflect the current system and business practice. This is basically a clean-up bill.
