ME	3	NS	safety belts, roll bar or enclosed cab, steering wheel or tiller, brakes on at least 2 main wheels; must meet general motorcycle inspection requirements	
MI	3	NS	safety belts, rollbar, windshield, wipers, steering wheel, "equipment otherwise required on a motorcycle"; helmet if roof that does not meet or exceed helmet standards	defined as "enclosed motorcycle"
OK	3	NS	safety belts, rollbar, windshield, wipers, steering wheel, "equipment otherwise required on a motorcycle"; helmet if roof that does not meet or exceed helmet standards	defined as "enclosed motorcycle"

Note: Kansas statutes generally do not specify safety equipment in definition statutes. KSA 8-1801 through 8-1810 specify safety equipment for motorcycles. The required equipment includes headlamps, taillamps, reflectors, stop lamps and turn signals, road-lighting equipment, brakes, horns, mufflers, mirrors, and tires that meet certain standards.				
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
