Senator Olson opened the meeting with a welcome and pointed out to committee members to notice draft committee minutes in their packets that would be considered and approved during the Wednesday meeting.

Possible bill introductions

Senator Olson called for any bill introduction requests.

Commissioner Pat Apple representing the Kansas Corporation Commission requested a bill introduction that would provide a seven year extension to the sunset clause of the abandoned oil and gas well fund. The bill proposes a seven year extension of: the transfer of \$100,000 every 90 days to the abandoned oil and gas fund from each of three sources: 1.) state general fund; 2.) state water fund; 3.) conservation fund fee.

<u>Senator Longbine motioned to accept the bill introduction request and Senator Francisco seconded the</u> motion. The motion passed.

Mike Scott representing AT&T and other utilities requested a bill introduction concerning a disaster recovery plan. The bill proposes to expedite recovery processes during a declared emergency by temporarily waiving certain regulations (business registrations, permitting, tax filing requirements) for both local and out of state employees.

<u>Senator Petersen motioned to accept the bill introduction request and Senator Wilborn seconded the motion. The motion passed.</u>

Seeing no additional bill introduction requests Senator Olson closed possible bill introductions.
