

## Definitions

Data transmission technology that provides a two-way Broadband link to and from the Internet.

## Fixed Connections Include:

Wireline

Technology that enables service to a fixed location

using copper, cable, or fiber lines.

Fixed Wireless

Technology that enables service to a fixed location using a dedicated frequency of the broadcast spectrum. Source: www.broadbandmap.gov/classroom/technology

This map depicts residential and "business-only" service area.
