6 New Section 1. (a) The legislative division of post audit shall conduct
7 information technology audits as directed by the legislative post audit
8 committee. Audit work performed under this section may include:

9 (1) Assessment of security practices of information technology
10 systems maintained or administered by ~~an any state agency or any entity~~
11 subject to audit under the provisions of K.S.A. 46-1114(c), and
12 amendments thereto; {and}

13 (2) ~~data mining of electronic records maintained by an any state~~
14 ~~agency or any entity subject to audit under the provisions of K.S.A. 46-~~
15 ~~1114(c), and amendments thereto, in order to examine such records for~~

18 (3) {(2)} continuous audits of ongoing information technology

24 (b) Written reports on the results of such auditing shall be furnished
25 to the governor, the entity which is being audited, the chief information
26 technology officers of the executive, legislative and judicial branches, the
27 legislative post audit committee, the joint committee on information
28 technology and such other persons or agencies as may be required by law
29 or by the specifications of the audit or as otherwise directed by the
30 legislative post audit committee.

31 (c) The provisions of K.S.A. 46-1106(g), and amendments thereto,
32 shall apply to any audit or audit work conducted pursuant to this section.

33 (d) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the legislative

information technology; relating to the
office of information technology services

New Sec. 2. For the purpose of preparation of the governor's budget report and related legislative measure or measures for submission to the legislature, the office of information technology services, established in K.S.A. 75-4701, and amendments thereto, shall be considered a separate state agency and shall be titled for such purpose as the "office of information technology services." The budget estimates and requests of such office shall be presented as from a state agency separate from the department of administration, and such separation shall be maintained in the budget documents and reports prepared by the director of the budget and the governor, or either of them, including all related legislative reports and measures submitted to the legislature.
