Subject: 16rs4280, Reconciling Amendments to Certain Statutes

16rs4280 reconciles amendments to certain statutes which have been amended more than once during the prior legislative session. The purpose of the reconciliation bill is to combine non-contradictory amendments from enacted legislation to produce one version of the statute. Without reconciling amendments, two versions of the statute will exist.

Amendatory Sections for Statutes Amended More than Once

Section 1. K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 44-706 was amended twice during the 2015 session and reconciles a conflict with K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 44-706c. Employment security law, disqualification for benefits.

Repealed Only Sections

When different bills make the same amendments to the same statute, one version of the bill or statute must be repealed to resolve having two versions of the same statute. 16rs4280 addresses this issue by repealing duplicative statutes in section 2.
