"(14) An individual shall be permanently ineligible for TANF assistance if such individual is convicted of any felony violation of the following occurring on or after July 1, 2015: Mistreatment of a dependent adult or mistreatment of an elder person, as defined in K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5417, and amendments thereto; theft, as defined in K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5801, and amendments thereto; forgery, as defined in K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5823, and amendments thereto; criminal use of a financial card, as defined in K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-5828, and amendments thereto; identity theft or identity fraud, as defined in K.S.A. 2014 Supp. 21-6107, and amendments thereto; or violation of the Kansas offender registration act, as defined in K.S.A. 22-4903, and amendments thereto.";

On page 21, in line 11, by striking "in" and inserting "on";

And by redesignating subsections, paragraphs, subparagraphs and clauses accordingly
