SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2007 by Representative Dove, et al.

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2007 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2007 would establish a law enforcement mutual aid region for critical incidents. The mutual aid region would include the Kansas counties of Johnson, Leavenworth, Miami, and Wyandotte and the Missouri counties of Platte, Clay, Ray, Jackson, and Cass. HB 2007 would take effect upon its publication in the Kansas Register.

Because of the inability to determine the frequency and nature of critical incidents, the fiscal effect of enactment of HB 2007 cannot be estimated. However, the Kansas Highway Patrol indicates that the bill could increase its salaries and wages expenditures if a critical incident causes overtime for its staff. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2007 is not reflected in The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report.
