**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2009 by Legislative Post Audit Committee

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2009 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the Post Auditor may require employees of the Division of Post Audit to be fingerprinted and submit to a state and national criminal history record check. HB 2009 would allow the Post Auditor to require contractors, temporary workers, and any other individuals under the direction of the Post Auditor to submit to a criminal history record check.

Enactment of HB 2009 could result in additional costs relating to the criminal background checks, including fingerprinting costs. The number of additional background checks that would be performed is not known. However, any additional costs would be borne by the existing budget of the Division of Post Audit and is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
