SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2042 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2042 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2042 would make clarifications pertaining to membership on the Governor's Behavioral Health Services Planning Council. Currently, the Commissioner of Juvenile Justice is a required member of the Council. HB 2042 would instead require the Deputy Secretary of Juvenile Services of the Department of Corrections to serve on the Council. In addition, the bill would require that the Governor's Tribal Liaison be one member of the Council.

The Department for Aging and Disability Services states that any additional expenditures resulting from passage of HB 2042 could be covered within current resources. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2042 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
