**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2043 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2043 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Current statutes allow the Secretary of the Department for Children and Families to access KBI background checks as necessary for determining an individual's qualifications for employment or participation in programs for the placement, safety, protection or treatment of vulnerable children or adults. HB 2043 would allow the Secretary of the Department for Aging and Disability Services to have the same access.

Both the Department for Children and Families and the Department for Aging and Disability Services state that passage of HB 2043 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
