SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2088 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2088 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2088 would require a law enforcement officer to provide a notice to a licensee when a liquor violation is detected in order for the Director of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) to facilitate an administrative citation against the license. The notice would need to include the name of the licensee, the date and time of the alleged violation, a description of the alleged violation and a statement that a report will be submitted to ABC.

The Department of Revenue indicates that HB 2088 would have no fiscal effect on state expenditures, but could result in an increase in revenues from fines issued to liquor licensees although the amount cannot be determined.
