SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2090 by House Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2090 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2090 would remove the requirement that each city, county, township, school district, community college or technical college file an annual report with the Division of Vehicles of the Department of Revenue identifying the vehicles registered with their own license plates.

The Department of Revenue indicates HB 2090 would have no fiscal effect on agency operations.
