SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2096 by House Committee on Commerce, Labor and Economic Development

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2096 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, property owners' associations are prohibited from making or enforcing restrictions against the display of certain political signs in a common interest community. HB 2096 would amend the law to allow the associations to restrict the display of political signs on common areas or facilities.

According to the League of Kansas Municipalities, passage of HB 2096 would have no fiscal effect on Kansas cities.
