SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2163 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2163 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2163 would amend the Interlocal Cooperation Act to expand the Act's definition of "municipality" to include a school district, library district, road district, drainage district, sewer district, and fire district.

According to the Kansas Association of Counties, passage of HB 2163 would have no fiscal effect on the counties of Kansas. According to the League of Kansas Municipalities, passage of the bill could result in some cost savings for districts that take advantage of interlocal agreements, as it would permit those districts to enter into contracts for services with other public entities. Without knowing how many districts would be affected by the Act or details of individual contracts, however, the League is unable to estimate what the savings might amount to.
