SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2165 by House Committee on Local Government

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2165 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2165 would amend existing law concerning vacancies in the office of a director of an improvement district. The bill would require that the person appointed to fill a vacancy in the office of the director of the Peck Improvement District in Sumner and Sedgwick counties must be filled by a resident of one of the two counties. The Board of County Commissioners of Sumner County would make this appointment. Appointments in any other improvement districts in the state would not be affected by the bill.

According to the Kansas Association of Counties, passage of HB 2165 is not expected to have a fiscal effect on any Kansas county. The Board of County Commissioners of Sumner County is already holding regular meetings at which an appointment would be made.
