SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2175 by House Committee on Federal and State
Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2175 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2175 would make a change to a provision of the Pet Animal Act. The bill would prohibit the use of carbon monoxide chambers for the purpose of euthanizing dogs and cats. Current law requires the use of only the most current, approved euthanasia methods established by the American Veterinary Medical Association panel on euthanasia.

The Kansas Department of Agriculture indicates that the bill would have no fiscal effect for the Department.
