SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2204 by House Committee on Health and Human Services

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2204 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2204 would create the Claim Information Reporting Act. The bill would require health insurance issuers to provide within 21 days after a written request from a plan, plan sponsor or plan administrator a claim information report. The bill includes definitions for terms and details how the report can be delivered or made available, the information required in the report, and how additional information may be requested. The bill would also provide for short-term medical plans.

The Kansas Insurance Department states that passage of HB 2204 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
