SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2231 by House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2231 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2231 would reduce from \$100 to \$25 the annual licensing fee for any applicant operating one or more gas wells used exclusively for the purpose of heating a residential dwelling or other structure on the applicant's premises.

The Kansas Corporation Commission indicates that there are currently 100 active residential licenses in the state. The bill would reduce revenue to the Conservation Fee Fund by approximately \$7,500.
