SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2301 by House Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2301 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2301 would authorize the House Committee on Judiciary to meet when the Kansas Legislature is not in session for the purpose of judicial nominations under authority of Section 5 of Article 3 of the *Kansas Constitution*.

According to Legislative Administrative Services, for each day that the House Committee on Judiciary would meet under provisions of HB 2301, expenditures of \$10,266 from the State General Fund would be required. This estimate includes \$9,516 for travel and subsistence expenditures, \$450 for employer fringe benefit costs, and \$300 for a committee assistant. The number of days that the committee would meet is not known. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2301 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
