SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2407 by House Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2407 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2407 would provide for public-private agreements concerning state infrastructure projects as specified in the bill.

According to the Adjutant General's Department and the Department of Administration, enactment of HB 2407 would have no fiscal effect. The Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) states the fiscal effect resulting from the passage of HB 2407 would depend on terms and conditions negotiated in the project agreement. Until given an opportunity to operate under the provisions of HB 2407, KDOT is unable to estimate a precise fiscal effect at this time. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2407 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
