In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2518 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2518 would require that all death or stillbirth certificates and medical certifications be filed electronically with the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE), beginning January, 2017.

Passage of HB 2518 would have no fiscal effect on state revenues or expenditures.
