**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2598 by Representative K. Jones

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2598 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2598 would amend existing law concerning rural water districts which have a water benefit unit attached to land within the district. When that land is subject to foreclosure and sale, any benefit unit attached to the land could not be forfeited, or if it was forfeited, could be reinstated under conditions specified in the bill.

Because HB 2598 is concerned with rural water districts, passage of the bill would have no fiscal effect on the Department of Agriculture, Kansas counties, or Kansas municipalities.
