SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2635 by Representative Carmichael

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2635 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2635 would require that the Workers Compensation and Employment Security Boards Nominating Committee select a chairperson annually. Beginning in July 2016, the initial order of the rotating chairperson would be decided by chance and would rotate among the seven members of the Committee that represent each of the following:

1. Secretary of Labor;
2. Kansas Chamber of Commerce;
3. National Federation of Independent Business;
4. Kansas AFL-CIO;
5. Kansas State Council for the Society for Human Resource Management;
6. Kansas Self-Insurers Association; and
7. Employee organization or a professional employees' organization.

The Department of Labor indicates HB 2635 would have no fiscal effect.
