SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for HB 2674 by Representative Alcalá

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2674 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Under current law, the Governor and Lieutenant Governor may solicit and accept campaign contributions at any time. HB 2674 would change current law by prohibiting the Governor and Lieutenant Governor from soliciting and accepting campaign contributions after the inauguration date of their second successive term.

The Governmental Ethics Commission indicates HB 2674 would have no fiscal effect on the agency. However, HB 2674 would have a fiscal effect on individuals that contribute to and receive campaign contributions if those contributions relate to the Office of the Governor and Lieutenant Governor. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2674 is not reflected in *The FY 2017 Governor's Budget Report*.
