SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 127 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 127 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 127 would require that on and after July 1, 2015, the Secretary of Transportation could not place any signs commemoratively designating any highway, bridge, interchange, or trail until the Secretary has received sufficient funds from gifts and donations to cover the cost of placing the signs and an additional 50.0 percent of the initial cost to defray future maintenance.

The Kansas Department of Transportation indicates there would be no fiscal effect on agency operations resulting from the passage of SB 127.
