SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 13 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 13 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 13 would change the types of information that are excluded from entry into the criminal justice information system central repository. Under current law, information regarding the release of defendants from confinement by the Department of Corrections or a jail is excluded from an offender's record of criminal history. The bill would instead exclude information regarding the release of defendants from confinement, assignment to work release, or any other change in custody status of a person confined by the Department of Corrections or a jail.

Enactment of SB 13 would have no fiscal effect.
