SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 153 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 153 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 153 would exempt any state or municipal building operated as a public library from the provisions of the Personal and Family Protection Act.

The Office of Judicial Administration indicates it is possible that some individuals might file suit to challenge the application of SB 153; however, the Office estimates any fiscal effect to the Judicial Branch would be negligible. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 153 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
