SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 173 by Senate Committee on Transportation

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 173 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 173 would create the following distinctive license plates: Korean War, Operation Desert Storm, Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom. This bill would waive the distinctive license plate fee for these plates, and would authorize the transfer of the plate to the surviving spouse or other family member if there is no spouse.

The Department of Revenue estimates changes to computer processing systems would increase expenditures from the Division of Vehicles Operating Fund by \$3,625 in FY 2016. Any fiscal effect associated with SB 173 is not reflected in *The FY 2016 Governor's Budget Report*.
