**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 190 by Senate Committee on Commerce

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 190 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 190 would amend existing law concerning boating safety education requirements for operation of a motorboat or sailboat. The bill would exempt individuals operating a sailboat less than 20 feet long and participating in instructor-led sailing classes from the requirement to possess a certificate of completion of an approved boater safety education course. The bill would also exempt persons who could provide proof of having successfully completed an instructor-led sailing class.

According to the Kansas Department of Wildlife, Parks and Tourism, passage of SB 190 would not have a fiscal effect on the agency.
