SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 195 by Senate Committee on Judiciary

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 195 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 195 would amend the Kansas family law code relating to child support enforcement. The bill would clarify that the reporting of support arrearages to consumer credit reporting agencies would be done pursuant to rules and regulations adopted by the Secretary of the Department for Children and Families (DCF). The bill would also extend the effective date for changes in rules and regulations regarding the distribution of support payments from July 1, 2015 to July 1, 2020.

DCF states that passage of SB 195 would have no fiscal effect. The Office of Judicial Administration states that the bill would not affect Judicial Branch expenditures.
