SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 205 by Senate Committee on Federal and State Affairs

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 205 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

Each library board that participates in a regional system of cooperating libraries appoints one or two representatives to the system board. Current law requires representatives of territory not within the district of a participating library board, but within the territory of the regional system to be appointed by the Governor. SB 205 would transfer that authority to the State Librarian.

According to the State Library of Kansas, passage of SB 205 would have no fiscal effect on the agency.
