In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 209 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 209 would repeal the Competitive Bid Protection Act.

According to the Kansas Department of Transportation, the Board of Regents, the Department of Administration, and the Department of Labor, passage of SB 209 would have no fiscal effect. The League of Kansas Municipalities states passage of SB 209 would have a negligible fiscal effect upon cities.
