**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for SB 248 by Senate Committee on Ways and Means

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 248 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 248 would repeal the statute that authorizes key deposit funds.

During a review of state accounting policies, the Department of Administration discovered that the state correctional facilities and the state hospitals no longer use key deposit funds. Both the Department of Corrections and the Kansas Department for Aging and Disability Services confirm this and state that SB 248 would have no fiscal effect.
