SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 342 by Senate Committee on Education

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 342 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 342 would enact the Student Online Personal Protection Act. The bill would prohibit operators of certain educational online products from: engaging in targeted advertising; using personal student information to gather information about students; and selling, renting, or disclosing student information to a third party, with certain exceptions in the bill. The bill would also require online educational operators to implement and maintain reasonable security procedures and practices to protect student information.

According to the Department of Education, enactment of SB 342 would have no fiscal effect.
